BOARD ELECTIONS

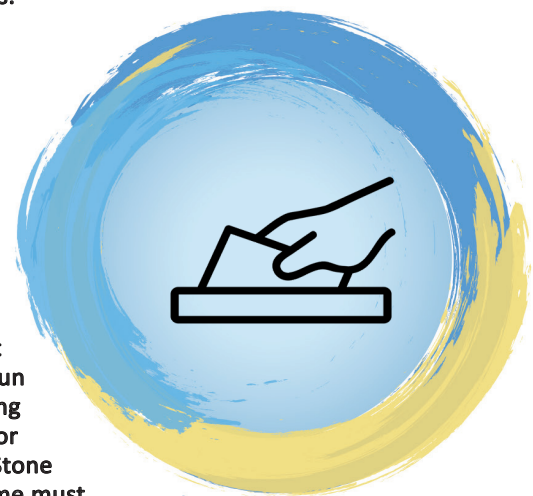
Three seats on the GreyStone Board of Directors are up for election in 2026. The GreyStone Power Nominating Committee has met and chosen John Walton in District 2 (Paulding County), Maribeth Wansley in District 6 (Fulton, Fayette and Coweta counties) and Milton Jones in District 7 (Fulton County) as their nominees for the Board of Directors. The winners will be announced in October following the Annual Meeting of Members.

Eligible members may become a candidate by being selected by the GreyStone Nominating Committee or by nomination by petition of members.

The deadline has passed to be nominated by the Nominating Committee, but eligible members may still run by petition. For those seeking nomination by petition, 50 or more signatures from GreyStone members of record (the name must appear on the electric bill) and a Candidate Affidavit must be submitted by Thursday, July 2. A petition form and the Candidate Affidavit can be found at greystonepower.com/board-elections.

All nominees must live within the geographic boundary of the district they seek to represent, are subject to a criminal background check and must meet all other conditions of eligibility set forth in the Bylaws.

Candidates wanting their name and biographical information included in the Annual Meeting ballot edition of *Georgia Magazine* must submit information in the format and manner required by the Credentials and Election Committee by Thursday, July 2. If you are unable to determine the district in which you reside, or if you need additional information, call GreyStone's independent legal counsel, Steve Minor, at 770-214-5108.

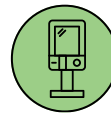
