The 2025 Foundation Scholarship application is now available at *greystonepower.com/scholarships*. Each year, GreyStone awards five \$3,000 scholarships to GreyStone members or their children who are either seniors in high school or enrolling in college annually. The scholarships are awarded based on need and academic achievement.

Since the Operation Round Up program began in 1998, GreyStone members have donated more than \$6.5 million to support these efforts.
